Royal Melbourne Club | Melbourne

The Royal Melbourne Golf Club is a private Members' Club founded in 1891 and has been host to numerous national and international events. They have a proud reputation of providing members and guests with friendly, welcoming and inclusive service.

Much has been written on the qualities of the West Course but put simply it's a combination of great design and construction. It is full of dramatic undulation, fertile sandy soil with a natural rugged appearance.

The East Course starts and finishes on the main site and is highlighted by seven 'home paddock' holes. The bunkering is superb while the greens, though smaller than the West's, are as beautifully constructed and sloped. It incorporates some of the most dramatic undulation on the course, the short four, long four, and mid four start is brilliant with clear risk and reward options from the tee and birdie to double bogey possibilities. The closing stretch starts with the short par 4 15th and the heavily bunkered 16th, which is the flattest 'home paddock' hole of either course but one of the best and most underrated par 3s in Melbourne. The final two holes are famously used on the world-renowned Composite Course.

Private Guided Experience | Phillip Island

A tiny island of pristine white sand beaches and a haven for wildlife. Phillip Island is known worldwide for its unique nature experience, the nightly Penguin Parade.

On arrival to the Island visit the rugged surf beach of Cape Woolamai and breathe what is considered the cleanest air in the world. Wander the treetop walks at the Koala Conservation Centre, enjoying superb eye-level viewing of Australia's most-loved and cuddly marsupial. Keep an eye out for resident wallabies and echidnas who are often spotted in the surrounding bushland. Clifftop boardwalks and epic coastal walks with thundering blowholes set amongst natural sea bird gardens will also feature on today's adventure. As the sun begins to set, travel off-road along the rugged island coastline to spot wild wallabies and Cape Barren geese, as they graze at dusk.

Once the sun disappears, the Penguin Parade begins with an eye-level view of the little penguins in the unique underground viewing experience. Enjoy up-close viewing of the little penguins waddling along the Parade's most popular pathway. Dinner will be had at the seaside village of Cowes at a local favourite.

Bottled water and travel snacks are complimentary when travelling in the vehicle. Please wear comfortable clothes and shoes today.



Notable Golf Courses Nearby

Lost Farms at Barnbougle - The 20-hole course at Lost Farm has been built on steeper dunes adjacent to The Dunes course (featured on the next page) and across the Great Forester River. This is an exciting and challenging course with strategic bunkering, undulating greens and wide fairways.

Bougle Run at Barnbougle - A short course consisting of 14 holes – 12x Par 3's and 2x Par 4's – shaped into the ridge of dunes that surround the 8th and 11th holes of Lost Farm. Designed by Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw, it's rumoured to be a lot of fun.

Scottsdale Golf Club - In Tasmania's northeast has a nine-hole fairly level course with water challenges. The well-watered fairways are bordered by Blackwood and Douglas Fir trees, a large lake presents a challenge on the 7th and 8th holes, and there are 10 bunkers. Nine holes, Par 70, 5436 metres.

Country Club Tasmania - An international standard 18-hole golf course in Launceston, originally designed and built as part of the property in 1982 by world famous golfers and course designers Mike Wolveridge and Peter Thomson. A typical Thomson/Wolveridge design, with a mixture of links and parkland styling, features include large challenging fairways, water hazards and fast greens. The 18-hole course has grown to be one of the best golf courses in Tasmania and is meticulously maintained by our team of greenkeepers.



The Dunes Golf Course | Barnbougle

The Dunes, Barnbougle's original course, is a Links Golf Course unlike any other in Australia. Meandering along Tasmania's dramatic Northeast coast, it's where breath taking scenery and thrilling golf truly come together. A blend of fescue and bent grasses, the course flourishes in the coastal environment. Fairways are wide, wider than most golfers will have experienced on traditional courses. The greens are lively; rolling with the natural undulation of the dunes and with the 4th hole boasting the largest bunker in the southern hemisphere, this course is designed to challenge.

The greens at Barnbougle Dunes run at speeds closely resembling the original greens of the great British links. Contoured in tune with the tumbling land around them, the greens feature a combination of broad slopes and ridges through the playing lines.

Northern Tasmania Birding Experience | Scottsdale

Not everyone on this trip may play golf, and while in Scottsdale we recommend a day with Pepperbush Adventures. Explore a fantastic array of habitats and a diverse range of bird species in northeast Tasmania. One example is the coastal regions of Mt William National Park and Bridport Wildflower Reserve or the varied forest and farmland habitats in the heart of northeast Tasmania, all near Scottsdale.

Birds and beaches are abundant in Mt William National Park (near the Bay of Fires) with honey eaters, wrens, robins, finches, and pardalotes found in the Park. It is also home to yellow tailed cockatoos, harriers, white bellied sea eagles and wedge-tail eagles. Migratory birds like short-tailed shearwaters and the occasional albatross may also be sighted. Like Mt William, the Bridport Wildflower Reserve and surrounding areas are also known to be home to over 100 bird species including endemics, green rosella, yellow wattlebird, and yellow throated honeyeaters.

The women's and men's locker rooms are fully appointed with day lockers, showers, towels, and sunscreen. Should you wish to have lunch between the nines, an order can be placed with the Pro Shop before teeing off. Additionally, a full lunch menu is available after the round in the clubhouse dining room.
